BUS BEHAVIOR FOR STUDENTS:

- Use assigned bus stop. If a student has to cross the street follow the direction(s) of the driver.
- Be on time and board the bus in an orderly manner. Your student should be at the designated bus stop five (5) minutes before the pick up time.
- Take assigned seat, share your seat with others and remain face forward.
- When talking use inside voice – absolutely no shouting, screaming, or whistling, this is a must for student and driver safety.
- Be courteous and thoughtful of other students. Fighting, pushing, hitting, kicking will not be tolerated.
- Use appropriate language.
- Keep hold of all personal belongings, and keep all body parts inside the bus if the windows are open.
- Keep the aisle clear. All personal items must be kept on your lap or under the seat if directed.
- In regards to eating or drinking, follow the bus driver's directions.
- Follow the instructions of the bus driver or other adults on the bus.
- Help keep your bus clean, throw all litter in the waste basket when leaving the bus.
